## FORA Board Elections and Officers And Committee Appointments*

Each year the Executive Committee appoints a nominating committee at their November or December meeting. The nominating committee presents a slate of officers for election at the end of the first board meeting in January.

The FORA officers consist of the chair and $1^{\text {st }}$ vice chair. A past chair and a member-at-large are also selected and appointed/confirmed by the vote to serve on the Executive Committee. All serve for one year. The officers may be reelected for no more than one consecutive additional term in the same office.

The Executive Committee is comprised of not more than five members of the Board: the 3 elected officers, a past chair and a member-at-large. The Board is authorized to appoint a representative from the Board to fill any vacancies.

The members of the Legislative, Finance, and Administrative Committees are appointed by the Chair and confirmed by the Board at the February board meeting. All members serve for one year.

The Legislative Committee is comprised of up to five members and three ex-officio members, one each from the $17^{\text {th }}$ Congressional District, the $15^{\text {th }}$ State Senate District, and the $27^{\text {th }}$ State Assembly District.

The Finance Committee is authorized to have a total of six members consist of a chief administrative officer, a county administrative officer or a city manager, or designee, from each FORA member agency.
