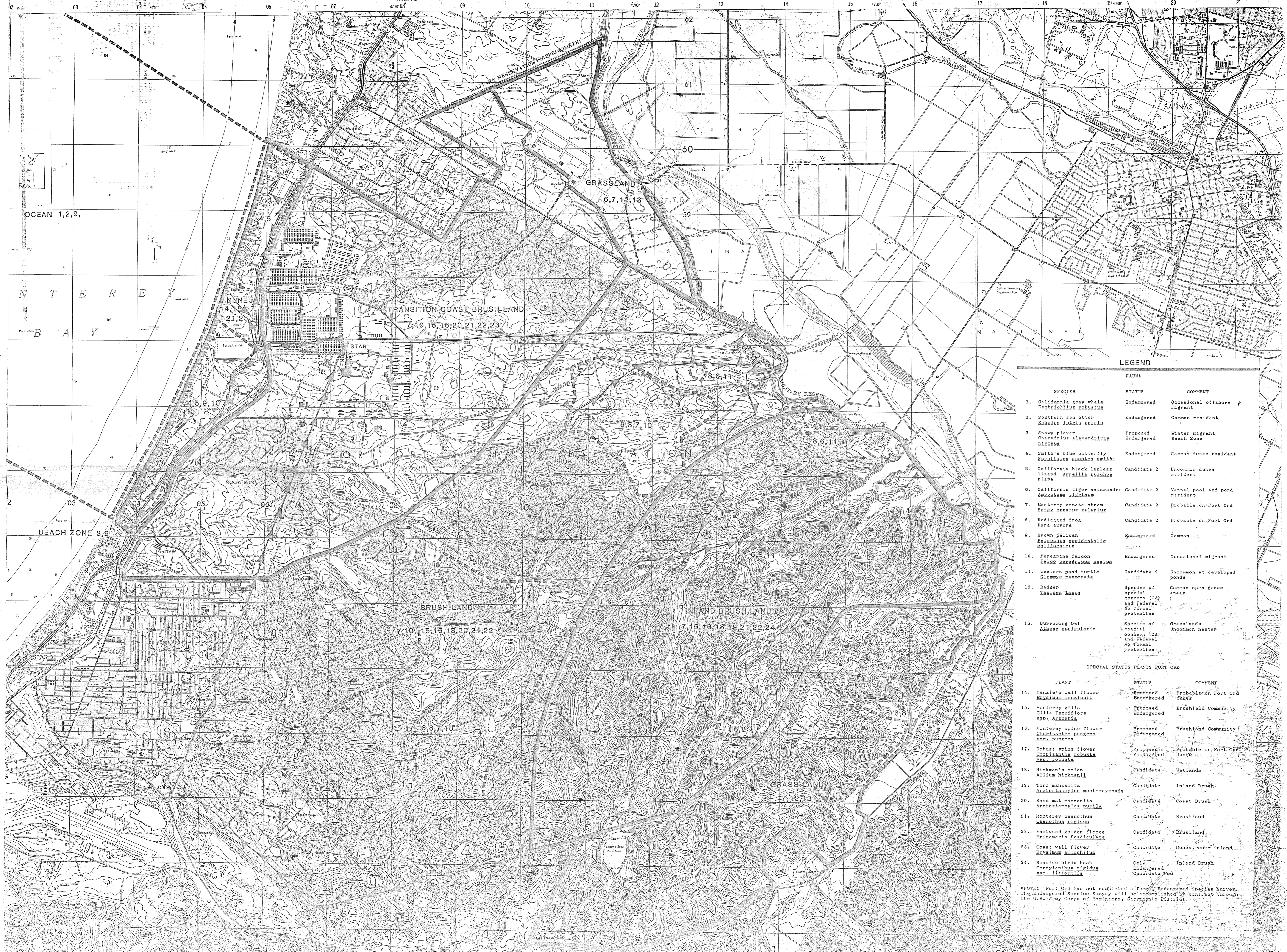


FORT ORD AND VICINITY OF

7. Monterey ornate shrew <i>Sorex ornatus salinus</i>	Candidate 2	Probable on Fort Ord
8. Red-legged frog <i>Rana aurora</i>	Candidate 2	Probable on Fort Ord
9. Brown pelican <i>Pelecanus occidentalis californicus</i>	Endangered	Common
10. Peregrine falcon <i>Falco peregrinus anatum</i>	Endangered	Occasional migrant
11. Western pond turtle <i>Clemmys marmorata</i>	Candidate 2	Uncommon at developed ponds
12. Badger <i>Taxidea taxus</i>	Species of special concern (CA) and Federal No formal protection	Common open grass areas
13. Burrowing Owl <i>Athene unicularia</i>	Species of special concern (CA) and Federal No formal protection	Grasslands Uncommon nester

15. Monterey gilia <i>Gilia tenuiflora</i> ssp. <i>arcanaria</i>	Proposed Endangered	Brushland Community
16. Monterey spine flower <i>Chorizanthe pungens</i> var. <i>pungens</i>	Proposed Endangered	Brushland Community
17. Robust spine flower <i>Chorizanthe robusta</i> var. <i>robusta</i>	Proposed Endangered	Probable on Fort Ord dunes
18. Hickman's onion <i>Allium hickmanii</i>	Candidate	Wetlands
19. Toro manzanita <i>Arctostaphylos monterevensis</i>	Candidate	Inland Brush
20. Sand mat manzanita <i>Arctostaphylos pumila</i>	Candidate	Coast Brush
21. Monterey ceanothus <i>Ceanothus rigidus</i>	Candidate	Brushland
22. Eastwood golden fescue <i>Ericameria fasciculata</i>	Candidate	Brushland
23. Coast wall flower <i>Erysimum amnophilum</i>	Candidate	Dunes, some inland
24. Seaside birds beak <i>Cordylanthus rigidus</i> ssp. <i>littoralis</i>	Cal. Endangered Candidate Fed	Inland Brush
