Dear FORA Board:

The Veteran Cemetery project environmental review still has one week left for public comment. Phase One is planned for 16.9 acres which include coastal live oak woodland shown in the attached photo. It is estimated that 475 trees would be removed and 114 planted, a net loss of 361 trees. The mitigated negative declaration proposes 16 mitigation measures, but none would protect coastal live oaks.

During tomorrow's public comment period, I'll update you on my efforts to get CalVet to include a mitigation measure that would protect onsite coastal live oaks.
