- Provide a primary southwest-northeast corridor through former Fort Ord, while maintaining an acceptable level of service throughout the FORA CIP **and regional** roadway network with the implementation of the approved reuse of Fort Ord
- ~~De-emphasize Inter Garrison Road as a major vehicular route with greater emphasis placed on pedestrian and bicycle traffic~~
Recognize Intergarrison Road as a vehicular route while providing the greater accommodation of pedestrian and bicycle traffic
- ~~Utilize~~ **Fully evaluate the utilization of** existing roadways as the foundation for the future network
