2010 FORA Completed joint construction of:

- General Jim Moore Boulevard (GJMB)
- Eucalyptus Road

2014 City of Seaside notified FORA of slope failures along Eucalyptus Road and GJMB

2015 C+D Engineers updated the General Permit with California Water Resource Control Board (WRCB)

2016 FORA had a turn-over in Engineering Staff

2017 Board Approval of engineering and MEC coordination contracts

2017-18 Parikh Geotechnical to perform a Root Cause Analysis


Eucalyptus Road





Eucalyptus Road







- Since 2018:
- Staff worked with engineering to decrease the scope from 5 infiltrator repairs to 3, saving \$750K
- FORA decreased long-term maintenance costs with a sustainable bio-retention system
- FORA created a programmatic construction support plan (CSP) – facilitating future digging for maintenance on adjacent munitions response areas

Eucalyptus Road



- Harris and Associates have prepared 90% plans and estimates of probable cost
- Whitson Engineers completed a plan check
- Reimer and Associates has coordinated Specifications pertaining to training and monitoring for on-call constructions support
- FORA has coordinated with City of Seaside engineering
- November 2019 Received DTSC, EPA, and ARMY sign-off on Construction Support Plan



Project is ready for Public Bid and Construction: FORA Budget:

Estimated Bid Time: January 2020 Estimated Date of Completion: <u>May 30, 2020</u>



- What happens if project has overruns past June 30, 2020?
 - Harris and Associates is the CM for FORA & the City of Seaside – ensuring continuity
 - Contracts identify the City of Seaside as the FORA successor and assign to the project
 - Project Budget has a <u>25%</u> contingency to decrease risk of overruns.

Staff Recommendation



 Authorize the Executive Officer (EO) to execute all bidding requirements and associated contracts for the completion of Eucalyptus Road infiltrator repairs not to exceed a project budget of \$1,102,500
