The Fort Reuse Authority (FORA) is pleased to announce the opening of the Community Information Center (CIC) at 920 2nd Avenue, Marina, CA 93933. The FORA CIC is an interactive resource facility for public use that provides information to the public about FORA and the educational, environmental, and economic purposes of reuse of the former Fort Ord.

FORA's CIC combines a variety of interactive options including uses of historical artifacts, touchscreen computers, and other media to engage and inform on subjects such as the history of Fort Ord, the base reuse plan, the current reassessment of the base reuse plan, ordnance and explosives removal, habitat preservation, construction projects, and recreational opportunities, including information about the recent National Monument designation.
