Realities and Conclusion



- √ 2019/20 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) was approved by Board with the requirement to verify Community Facilities District (CFD) funds
- Reduction of FORA staff/resources and FORA's pending sunset on June 30th prohibited successful completion of CIP Priority Projects
- ✓ If CFD/Building Removal funds are not allocated/ transferred, all funds will be assumed by Monterey County
- Litigation active and threatened impact FORA's ability to execute projects and will likely impact available funds
- > Therefore FORA is working with jurisdictions to transfer projects, funds, and available consultant contracts

Budget Status



CFD/Developer Fees

- Used for Capital Improvement Program
- ✓ Fund Balance as of 6/30/19: \$ 28.8M
- ✓ Assigned for the HCP: \$ 16.1M
- ✓ Fees budgeted for FY 19-20: \$ 7.8M
- ✓ Fees received as of 2/28/20: \$ 2.9M
- \$5M lower than projected budget

Lease and Sale Proceeds

- ✓ Used for Building Removal Program
- ✓ Fund Balance as of 6/30/19: \$ 7.3M
- ✓ Assigned to MCP Settlement: \$ 3 M
- Need to reserve \$s for potential settlement
